### Definitions:

**» Development region«** is a functional territory for implementation of regional development policies, with economical and infrastructural settlements as well as balanced natural systems, incorporated into a spatial community without distinction where equal opportunities for balanced regional development can be provided;

**» Regional development «** is a general effort to reduce regional disparities by supporting (employment and wealth/welfare generation) economic activities in the regions;

**»Regional disparities«** is a situation where there are substantial differences between certain regions compared to other regions in some socio-economic indicators (GDP/Capita; per capita investment; unemployment rate etc.) but not only;

**»Balanced regional development«** the process of reducing distinctions in terms of socioeconomic development and quality of life in different regions;

**»Regional Development Policies«** provide the regional development framework and interventions in specific areas that will be directed towards achieving the goal of balanced regional development;

**» The National Development Strategy«** is a document that aims to address main obstacles for Kosovo's development and represents a document of development initiatives that are national objectives with a broad social consensus;

**» The Medium Term Expenditure Framework«** is the main document based on which is drafted the budget of the Government of the Republic of Kosovo. The main purpose of the MTEF is to provide a grounded analysis of the macroeconomic environment in the country, thus establishing the basis for budget planning for years to come in line with the Government's strategic priorities;

**» The Capital Project«** - a long-term investment that is used to build, grow or improve assets, according to established criteria, as set out in Administrative Instruction no. 04/2019 on Defining Capital Projects and Classifying Capital Project Expenditures..

#### I. Introduction

Pursuant to its legal mandate set out in Annex 16 of Regulation (GR) No. 07/2020 on amending and supplementing the regulation 06/2020 on the Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, as well as the Work Plan for 2020, the Ministry of Regional Development has prepared the "Analysis of capital investments made by development regions in Kosovo for 2019".

Through this document, MRD aims to reflect the capital investments made by line Ministries in five (5) development regions in Kosovo during 2019: Centre, East, North, West, South. What was the amount of capital investments distributed by the line Ministries during 2019, which were the ministries that financed the most or the least capital projects in the municipalities, which was the development region and the municipality that benefits the most or the least investments capital from LM, what were the sectors in which investments were distributed and which were the sectors that benefited the most and the least, how much was the balanced distribution of investments between the regions, etc. Basically, these are just some of the questions that are answered in this document, and all of them are subject to a comparison with the previous year 2018.

In contrast to the capital investment analysis of last year 2019 for 2018, in the Capital investment analysis prepared in 2020 for 2019, a new element is addressed, the capital investments of municipalities are reflected, i.e. from their own budgets. The sectors where the municipalities themselves have implemented capital projects during the fiscal year 2019 have been identified. The projects implemented in partnership between municipalities have also been addressed, which in fact are in minimal numbers and in this respect it remains for the MRD to focus more in order to promote cooperation of municipalities within the regions.

The treatment of all capital investments (central and local) is done taking into account the financed projects that belong to the public sectors / local and regional public infrastructure, generally related to the fulfilment of the own competencies of the municipalities defined by Law no. 03 / L - 040 for Local Self-Government.

Based on the administrative instruction of the Ministry of Finance, no.04 / 2019, capital investments have a general social and economic impact of the country and / or the achievement of strategic objectives of budget organizations. Capital investment is expected to provide new improvement or benefit such as capacity expansion, cost reduction or similar benefits as well as investment is expected to provide benefits over many years.

Preparation of this analysis has built on the following: Report of Budget Appropriations and Capital Investment Expenditures for 2019 of the Treasury Department of the Ministry of Finance, and took into account the data and comments received from line ministries and municipalities.

#### II. Executive Summary

Good capital investment planning is essential for an effective budget management by a budget organization.

To achieve a good capital investment planning, it is important to consider the analysis and evaluations of investments made in the past years, the existing needs of the community, the balanced distribution of central investments to the local ones, as well as the fulfilment of predefined priorities.

Through the preparation and publication of this analysis, MRD aims to help by providing an important resource for planning and coordinating capital investments for the coming period, especially from the central level to the local level. This analysis deals in detail with the distribution of capital investments of line ministries during 2019, in relation to the five (5) development regions: Centre, East, North, West and South. The differences between the regions and municipalities are presented in terms of receiving support for the implementation of capital projects during a year. The types of investments realized by the line ministries in the municipalities are promoted, the possibility of assessing the interconnectedness of these investments with the mandate of the ministries is given.

Taking into account the mandate of MRD and its vision for the promotion of balanced regional development, the reflection of capital investments in this document is done in the Development Region, then materializing them in the respective municipalities of a region, the number of projects, sectors and distribution of investments in municipalities. The analysis provides an answer as to which development region in Kosovo has received the most capital investments from line ministries in 2019, in value of the total amount as a region.

Through this, it is aimed to promote balanced / equal regional development, influencing the reduction of differences that exist between different regions or less developed regions in socio-economic terms. Many small municipalities depend heavily on the central budget (Government Grant) and the investments of line ministries. Their non-involvement in capital investment support schemes absolutely affects the well-being of citizens and their local economic development.

#### III. Methodology

The analysis is based on the Report of Budget Appropriations and Capital Investment Expenditures for 2019 of the Treasury Department of the Ministry of Finance.

The lists of capital projects 2019 received by the line ministries, as well as the comments received in writing from the municipalities were also taken into consideration. The presentation of data related to central level capital investments in development regions are presented by grouping them at the level of the development region, then materializing them in municipalities.

Continuous communication was carried out with the representatives of the line Ministries (LM), the directors for economic development of the municipalities were consulted and the suggestions of the representatives of 5 (five) regional development agencies (RDAs) were taken into account.

The analysis was drafted by the Department for Planning and Regional Socio-Economic Analysis.

# IV. Calls for project proposals published by line Ministries

According to the legislation in force, all institutions, whether of local or central level, are obliged to respect the principle of transparency when spending public money. Ministries announce and launch programs for the distribution of capital investments at the local level. In order to reflect the forms of public announcement of municipalities for application with project proposals, we have researched the official websites of twelve (12) ministries.

Out of twelve (12) ministries we have managed to identify only 2 ministries which have published the calls for application for 2019 on their websites:

- Ministry of Local Government Administration, with the program entitled: Intermunicipal Cooperation Projects of socio-economic infrastructure to improve the living conditions of citizens, published on 27.02.2019.
- The Ministry of Regional Development has published the call entitled: "Regional Development Program 2019 Support to municipalities for the advancement of public infrastructure" published on 14.01.2020.

# V. Total capital investments in 2019 according to line ministries in development regions

MRD has addressed the capital investments of twelve (12) line ministries. The total budget invested by line ministries in municipalities for 2019 is € 94,081,060.89. The number of invested projects is 564.

Unlike 2018, in 2019 we have an increase in capital investments made by line Ministries. In 2018, funding was in the amount of 75,787,058.16 and with the number of projects 438. The difference between 2019 and 2018 is 18,294,002.73 or 11% more, while the number of most funded projects is 126.



According to table no.1 and graph no. 1, presented above, the three (3) ministries that have invested the most capital investments in development regions during 2019, are:

- 1. Ministry of Infrastructure, with total investments: 34,995,984.09 €;
- 2. Ministry of Public Administration, with total investments: € 18,729,969.51
- 3. Ministry of Education, Science and Technology, with total investments: 11,799,570.79 €

Similar to 2018 and 2019, the Ministry of Infrastructure leads with capital investments, which also has a larger investment difference in 2019 than 2018, in the amount of 7,149,794.14 or 11% and with 34 more projects per year 2019 as opposed to 2018

#### VI. Total capital investments in 2019 by sectors in development regions


An important and fundamental issue of this analysis is the treatment of the sectors in which investments have been made and identified according to the sources used as a basis. The investment sectors that are part of the treatment in this analysis, have been selected based on the Annual Financial Report of the budget of the Republic of Kosovo for 2019 of the Ministry of Finance. The following table summarizes the capital investments made, describing the sectors covered. The number of treated sectors is 15 which have been identified based on the description of capital project titles from the Annual Financial Report of the budget of the Republic of Kosovo for 2019 and the lists of capital projects received by the line Ministries. On this basis, unlike 2018 where 13 sectors were treated, in 2019 two (2) new sectors were added (15 sectors in total) confirmed by the Ministry of Economic Development: 1) Telecommunications and 2) Energy Efficiency. In this context, the determination of the amount of funding across sectors was made based on the description of funded projects and the list of sectors of the above report.

The sectors and the total capital investments realized in each sector during 2019, are presented as in the following table:

According to the table and chart no. 2, presented above, the three (3) sectors in which the most investment was made during 2019, are:

- 1. Construction of local roads: 37,592,438.03€
- 2. Educational facilities: 26,152,566.36€
- 3. Administrative and commercial buildings: 6,911,664.30€

Even in 2019 as in 2018, the local road sector leads, as the most invested sector in Kosovo. The investment of 2019 from 2018 is greater in the amount of 6,692,049.44 or 10%.

#### VII. Partnership projects implemented by two or more municipalities

The Ministry of Regional Development promotes the creation of networks of municipalities for the implementation of projects based on the common needs they have. However, unfortunately in 2019 a minimum number was observed in contrast to 2018. Projects invested by MRD in partnership with municipalities are presented in the following table:

# VIII. General information on five (5) regional development regions

Taking into account its legal mandate, defined in Annex 16 of Regulation (GR) No. 07/2020 on amending and supplementing the regulation 06/2020 on the Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, as well as the Work Plan for 2020, the Ministry of Regional Development is in charge of regional development policies, aimed at balanced regional socio-economic development in the Republic of Kosovo. In the framework of the objectives and the Work Plan for 2020, the Ministry of Regional Development in the context of Regional Development aims to draft policies and analytical documents in the context of reflecting and advancing the balanced regional socio-economic development in Kosovo.

MRD has drafted the Concept - Document for Regional Development which the Government of the Republic of Kosovo has approved with Decision no. 13/61 dated 22.08.2018 and with reference to the concept document, MRD drafts analyses and develops policies according to five (5) development regions:

- Development Region Centre
- Development Region East
- Development Region North
- Development Region West
- Development Region South

During 2019, MRD has drafted the document Regional Development Profiles which document aims to address regional specifics related to available areas, data and specifics for the population, as well as the demographic aspect across regions. Special focus in this document is given to the resources and potentials where the economic development can be oriented, consequently the balanced economic development of the development regions of Kosovo. The document addresses the level of education of the population, potentials in the field of agriculture, tourism, business profiles operating within these regions, the conditions for doing business, as well as the level of infrastructure that is in function of development. The document is published on the official website of MARD in three official languages (Albanian, Serbian and English) or can be found at the following link:

MRD is in the finalization phase of the Draft - Strategy for Regional Development 2020 - 2030 which provides for objectives, multi-year orientations and the entire regional development regulative framework in Kosovo. After its approval, MRD will start drafting the first law in Kosovo that will regulate the field of regional development.

8.1 **Development Region Centre**, consists of 8 (eight) municipalities: Prishtina, Podujeva, Lipjan, Obiliq, Drenas, Shtime, Fushë Kosova and Graçanica. The Development Region Centre is bordered by the Region South in south-east, the Region North in north-east,

the Region East in south-east and Serbia in north-east.

Referring to the document "Profiles of Development Regions"<sup>1</sup> in Kosovo that MRD has drafted during 2019 the Development Region Centre has an area of 2,215.52 km2, a population of 512.398<sup>2</sup> inhabitants, according to the population estimate for 2019 and constitutes over 28.44% of entire population of Kosovo. The Region Centre constitutes about 20.31% of the entire territory of Kosovo which has an area of (10,905.25 km2). On average, in the development region Centre live approximately 230 inhabitants per 1 km2.

8.2 **Development Region East** consists of 11 (eleven) municipalities: Ferizaj, Gjilan, Han i Elezit, Kaçanik, Novobrda, Sterpca, Viti, Kllokot, Ranillug, Kamenica and Partesh. It borders with the development region centre on the north side, Serbia on the east, the development region south on the west side and Macedonia on the south side. The development region east has an area of 2,298.50 km2<sup>3</sup>, population of 323,154<sup>4</sup> inhabitants according to the population estimate for 2019 and constitutes 18.23% of the total population of Kosovo (1,782,115). The development region east constitutes about 21% of the entire territory of Kosovo (10,905.25 km2). On average, in the region east live about 142 inhabitants per 1 km2.

Data of the development region east are data obtained from the document "Profiles of Regional Regions in Kosovo".

8.3 Development Region North consists of seven municipalities: Mitrovica South, Mitrovica North, Leposavic, Zveçan, Zubin Potok, Vushtrri and Skenderaj. Development Region North borders with Serbia on the north side, with the region Centre on the northeast side, with region West on the west side.

Development Region North covers an area of 2,051.84 km2 or 18.81 % of the whole territory of Kosovo (10,905.25 km2)<sup>5</sup>. The total population of the region north is 222,472 <sup>6</sup> or 12.56% of the total population of Kosovo (1,782,115). The density of population in the development region north is 110 inhabitants per 1 km2.

8.4 **Development Region West** consists of six municipalities: Peja, Klina, Istog, Junik, Deçan and Gjakova. It borders with Montenegro on the northwest, while on the southwest it borders with Albania, on the northeast it borders with the development region north and on the southwest with the region south.

The development region west covers about 2,324.38 km or 21.31% of the total area of Kosovo (10,905.25 km2). With a total population of 321,488<sup>7</sup> inhabitants according to the population estimate for 2019 or approximately 17.99%<sup>8</sup> of the population of Kosovo. The population density is 139 inhabitants per km in the region West.

8.5 **Development Region South** consists of six municipalities: Rahovec, Malisheva, Prizren, Suhareka, Dragash and Mamusha. The region South lies in the southwestern part of Kosovo. It is bordered by Albania to the southwest, Macedonia to the southeast, on the east with the development region east, on the northeast to the development region centre and to the economic region West on the northwest.

The Development Region South covers about 2,015.01 km, 18.47% of Kosovo's territory (10,905.25<sup>9</sup> km2). With a population of 402,603<sup>10</sup> or 22.76 % of the general population of Kosovo. The population density is 203 inhabitants per square km in the region South.

#### IX. Capital investments by ministries in the Development Region Centre

11 Ministries have invested in the development region centre. Within this region, none of municipalities has benefited from at least one capital project from a line ministry.

The amount of financing of line ministries in this region is: 18,532,407.78 with a total number of projects amounting to 102. Unlike 2018, in 2019 there is a trend of increasing investments in the difference of 1,091,550.40 or 3.0%, while in the number of projects, there were 9 more in 2019 than in 2018.



- 1. Ministry of Infrastructure, with total investments: 5,411,355.29€
- 2. Ministry of Public Administration, with total investments: 5,371,335.99€
- 3. Ministry of Environment and Spatial Planning, with total investments: 2,431,710.10€

Compared to 2018, where there was a different ranking of ministries that have invested in this region (MCYS, MI, MEST), in 2019 MI leads (followed by MPA and MESP) also with an increase in investment of this ministry from 2018 in the amount of 273,157.23 or 26%.







- > The second municipality is the Municipality of Gllogovc in the amount of 2,896,484.58 and with a number of 19 capital projects invested.
- The third municipality is the Municipality of Podujeva in the amount of 2,832,914.02 and within this amount, 16 capital projects from the central level have been implemented.

From the above data and if we make a comparison with capital investments of last year (2018), it can be seen that the Municipality of Prishtina is the leading municipality in the Development Region Centre, which has received the most capital investments compared to other municipalities in this region. The Municipality of Prishtina has received large investments from the Ministry of Public Administration in the amount of 3,302,397.61€ in the sector of administrative / business facilities.





#### X. Capital investments by ministries in the Development Region East

12 Ministries have invested in the development region East. Within this region, all of the municipalities have benefited from at least one capital project from a line ministry.

The amount of funding of line ministries in this region is: 23,149,235.00 with total number of projects 140. Compared to 2018, in 2019 there is a growing trend of investments in the margin of 7,564,737.15 or 19.53%, among the number of projects 36 more in 2019 than in 2018. 



- 1. Construction of local roads: €12,588,037.00;

Construction of local roads is the most invested sector in 2019 in the development region East, similar to 2018 and with an increase of 3,481,124.00 or 16.0%.




Chart 8, Value of investments benefited by municipalities in the development region East





As seen in table no.14 and chart no. 10, presented above, in the following we are listing the three (3) sectors in which the most investment was made during 2019 in the region North, which are:

- 1. Educational facilities: €9,852,031.13 ;
- 2. Local roads: €3,492,657.56
- 3. Regulation on rivers: €1,716,499.87










Chart. 14 Value of investments benefited from the municipalities of the development region West





As seen in table no. 18 and chart no. 16, presented above, in the following we are listing the three (3) sectors in which the most investment was made during 2019 in the region South, which are:

- 1. Educational facilities: €5,523,929.10;
- 2. Local roads: €2,158,279.28 ;
- 3. Business administrative buildings: €1,101,569.31

In this region, in addition to changing the ranking of the three ministries that have invested the most, we have differences in the sector as opposed to 2018 where the following was leading: Construction of local roads, water supply, other capital. So, according to the data possessed by MRD, in 2019 three (3) new sectors were ranked as the most invested which in 2018 were ranked much lower. This evolution of investments is a good indicator in terms of comprehensive investment and in line with the needs that can move from year to year.

#### Value of investments benefited by municipalities in the development region South

Within the Development Region South, the municipality that has received the most funding for the implementation of capital projects is:

- Municipality of Suhareka in the amount of € 3,148,842.39 with a number of 20 projects invested from the central level.
- > The second municipality is the Municipality of Prizren in the amount of  $\in$  2,999,868.39 with a total number of projects of 28 projects, while

> The third municipality is Rahovec in the amount of  $\in$  2,814,923.00 and 16 projects invested by the Line Ministries.

Compared to last year (2018) and capital investment data for the development region South, the same Municipalities ranked in the first three of this year appear in the investments of 2018 where the Municipality of Prizren was leading, while this year is the Municipality of Suhareka. The Ministry that has invested the most in the Municipality of Suhareka in 2019 is the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology in the sector of educational facilities in the amount of € 1,066,342.39.

In more detail, regarding the financing of the municipalities of this region, the statistics are presented in chart no.17.




Chart. 17 Value of investments benefited by municipalities in the development region South

If we take into account the data presented in the table above that are issued by the Treasury Report/Ministry of Finance on capital expenditures realized in 2019, the presentation of own capital investments of municipalities/development regions by amounts and sectors where it was mostly invested, is reflected as follows:

- 1. **Development Region Centre**, with the most capital investments in 2019, in the amount of 45,159,224.09 €, with 469 projects. While in terms of sectors, in this region the sectors in which municipalities have invested the most are: Local Roads, Sidewalks, Buildings education.
- 2. Development Region East, in the amount of: 19,536,427.85 €, with 339 projects. The most invested sectors are: Local roads, sewerage and sidewalks.
- 3. **Development Region South**, It is estimated that it is the second region in a row that has made capital investments by the municipalities of this region, in the amount of €18,854,976.01, with 326 projects. The sectors in which the municipalities have invested the most in this region are: Local roads, Educational facilities, sidewalks.
- 4. **Development Region West**, in the amount of €17,905,068.00, with 359 projects. The most invested sectors are: local roads, water supply, and sidewalks.
- 5. Development Region North, the value of the investment is € 12,783,671.58, with 197 projects. The most invested sectors are: local roads, sidewalks, sewerage.

The table presents all the constituent municipalities of the region with the number of inhabitants according to the 2019 assessment, as well as the own capital investments they have made for 2019. From these values are presented the investments per capita of each Municipality, distinguishing three (3) Leading Municipalities of the development region East:

- > Municipality of Kllokot, € 116.93 investments per capita
- > Municipality of Hani i Elezit, € 97.69 investments per capita
- > Municipality of Ferizaj, € 90.20 investments per capita



## XVII. Balanced regional development in 2019

Balanced regional development is a strategic goal of the Ministry of Regional Development for a future period. Imbalances of regional developments are evident in the past years, therefore MRD aims to influence through the development of policies and documents that have an effect on the positive advancement in this field. Through this document, MRD has reflected the capital investments of line ministries for 2019. Out of five (5) development regions in Kosovo, the investment difference between the region with the most investments and the region with the least investments received by the central level, is 32%.


The chart below no. 19, shows the capital investments balanced by regions for 2019.






According to the graph above, the Region which has received the most capital investments from the line Ministries in 2019, is the Development Region East with an amount: 23,149,235.00 €. The second most developed region is the Development Region West with an amount of: 22,580,731.34 €. Whereas, the analysis has gone beyond investments at the level of regions by addressing the distribution of investments within the municipalities of a respective region. Out of 12 Ministries addressed in this document, 8 Ministries have distributed their capital investments in five (5) development regions.

However, this distribution has differences in balanced investments by one ministry in relation to one region with another. It is important to mention the fact that the number of ministries investing in five (5) development regions is increasing, in 2018 seven (7) investments were made, while in 2019 there are eight (8) ministries that have financed in five (5) development regions: Centre, East, South, North and West.



The charts below show the% of a ministry's investments in the five development regions.



Finally, the development regions that have benefited the most from capital line investments are: Development Region East, Development Region West, and Development Region Centre.

While at the level of Kosovo, the three municipalities that have benefited the most capital investments from the line Ministries, are:

**1.** Municipality of South Mitrovica: in the amount of  $\in$  11,490,630.73, with 22 projects.

**2.** Municipality of Ferizaj: in the amount of  $\in$  10,727,691.37, with 22 projects.

**3. The third municipality is the Municipality of Deçan**: in the amount of  $\in$  6,208,535.65, with 33 projects.

Also, it is worth mentioning that according to the statistics processed by MRD, the most funded sector from the central level in development regions but also from the local one, turns out to be the sector "Construction of local roads"

# XVIII. Conclusions and recommendations

Unlike 2018, in 2019, it has been observed that there is an overall increase in capital investment by line Ministries in development regions in Kosovo.

As a result, we can say that in 2019 we have a greater involvement of the number of regions in central level investments, where in 2018 we had seven (7) Ministries which have made investments in five (5) development regions, while in 2019 it was found that capital investments were distributed in five (5) development regions, by eight (8) line ministries.

It is worth noting that in 2019, an increase in investment was identified in some sectors which in 2018 have not been ranked in the top three most invested sectors of the year. What leaves much to be desired is the number of projects implemented in partnership, which can be recommended to the MRD to work with municipalities to identify areas and ideas for the implementation of projects with common interests.

Line ministries must adhere to the principle of transparency and publish calls for funding on their official websites. According to the research conducted by MRD, it turned out that only two (2) ministers have published the calls for project proposals on their websites. MRD needs to identify modalities for how it will coordinate communication with line ministries, in order to avoid duplication of investment by two or three ministries in the same development region / municipality.

This can now be done easily, when the MRD annually generates the list of capital investments extracted from the Treasury/Ministry of Finance Reports. Based on the investments of previous years, to prioritize the less invested sectors and to pay more attention to the National Development Strategy and the Government Program, in the phase of capital investment planning and drafting of investment criteria. Municipalities in cooperation with the central level should look at the possibility of financing the maintenance of capital investments, which

is very necessary since the investments made years ago can be returned to the initial situation.
