# INTRODUCTION

---

The Ministry of Regional Development (MRD) is a state body that operates on the basis of Law No. 06/L-113 on the Organization and Functioning of State Administration and Independent Agencies, Regulation No. 02/2021 on the Areas of Administrative Responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and Ministries, amended and supplemented by Regulation No. 04/2021 and Regulation No. 03/2022, and is responsible for preparing public policies, drafting legal acts, adopting by-laws, and defining mandatory standards in the field of regional development and implementing them.

The general aim of the MDR is to continuously contribute to balanced regional socio-economic development, with the aim of influencing the reduction of regional inequalities in all municipalities of the Republic of Kosovo through the drafting of strategies, the implementation of programs, the preparation of analyses, and the drafting of various documents. MDR operates with the implementation policies of its programs according to five (5) development regions with (38) constituent municipalities. Based on the Work Plan for 2023, DRSEPA has prepared the document: "Overview of Economic Resources According to Development Regions." In coordination and on the basis of good cooperation between the Ministry of Regional Development (MRD) and the Ministry of Economy (ME), the Department of Regional Socio-Economic Planning and Analysis (DRSEPA), through the drafting of this document, aims to present a clear overview of economic resources through an overview according to five development regions of the Republic of Kosovo. Central socio-economic region (*Municipality of Prishtina with surrounding municipalities*); Eastern socio-economic region (*Municipality of Gjilan with surrounding municipalities*); Western socio-economic region (*Municipality of Peja with surrounding municipalities*); Northern socio-economic region (*Municipality of South Mitrovica with surrounding municipalities*); Southern socio-economic region (*Municipality of Prizren with surrounding municipalities*); Each region is presented with the characteristics of economic resources.

## **Definitions**

**Development region** - means the functional territory that includes two or more local self-government units, in accordance with the criteria of NUTS-3, for the implementation of regional development policies, which is distinguished by a set of geographical, socio-economic, cultural, and environmental characteristics. The development region includes balanced regional socio-economic development in accordance with the Constitution and legislation in force and under no circumstances implies administrative or territorial organization;

**Balanced regional development** - means the process of reducing the differences in terms of socio-economic development as well as the approximation of the level of economic, social, cultural, and environmental development between different development regions through the use of their potentials in terms of financial resources, natural resources, and human capital;

**Regional inequality** - means the situation when substantial differences are evident between development regions according to socio-economic indicators;

**Public enterprises**- are basic units of production or commercial services within the economic system of a country. The main components of the enterprise are the people, the raw material or material processed by it, the technology used by it, the product or service provided by it, and the environment where it operates.

**Balanced regional development policies** - imply the framework of strategic and planning documents for regional development with the aim of interventions in certain areas that will be implemented in order to achieve the goal of balanced regional development. Depending on the changes and advancement of the strategic documents, the regional development objectives shall be referred to and adapted to the latest changes.

# ECONOMIC RESOURCES, ROLE AND IMPORTANCE

---

The overview of economic resources in development regions is a very important process that contributes to the effective management of economic resources. In addition to helping to identify the location and current state of these economic resources, it also helps to provide detailed information about these resources for exploiting their potential in order to influence balanced regional socio-economic development.

The **purpose** of this document is to, through an overview of the potential of economic resources, assist the drafters of regional policies in drafting programs for a balanced regional socio-economic development based on existing economic resources such as the mining sector, development in the field of energy, the importance and role of public enterprises, and telecommunications.

Main **objectives** of the overview of economic resources:

- issuance of statistics (numbers) and the distribution of economic resources on a regional basis;
- location of economic resources on a regional basis;
- capacity of economic resources on a regional basis;
- category, period of economic resources on a regional basis.

**Methodology:** During the preparation of this document, secondary data sources were used. The data are obtained based on the findings, publications, and various reports from the Ministry of Economy. The document has been consulted with the internal structures of the MRD and the ME on an ongoing basis in relation to the data of this field.

**Contribution:** This document provides an overview of the economic resources expressed in five (5) development regions and aims to use these information for drafting policies and programmes with regional impact by stimulating conceptual projects with a special approach to economic resources, which can directly affect balanced regional socio-economic development through the reduction of regional inequalities, thereby contributing to sustainable economic development.

**E**conomic resources are natural assets and material goods that show the values of a certain society. Kosovo is known and is rich with numerous economic resources that are a generator of socio-economic development. In addition to their impact on the economy, these resources have a great impact on the well-being of citizens.

In this document, the economic resources are reflected as follows:

1. Economic mineral resources;
2. Economic energy resources;
3. Public enterprises and telecommunications;
